Position Requirements:

Education & Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent (minimum)
- Minimum 3 years of experience as drill rig operator
- Knowledge in preventative maintenance, trouble-shooting drill rig issues and repair, welding, and other construction-related skills (preferred)

Licenses & Registrations:

- Valid US Driver's license and able to obtain vehicle insurance.
- CDL-A (Commercial Driver's License) A or B (preferred).
- Company-paid training required within 3 months of hire:
 - First aid & CPR, 10 hour OSHA, 40-hour HAZWOPER.

Physical Demands:

- Lift and move items that weigh up to 50 pounds, and perform various other tasks that require moderate physical exertion (e.g. setting up traffic control equipment, loading/unloading trucks, etc.).
- Comfortable working outdoors.
- Climb up and down ladders; work on elevated platforms, work in remote areas, and uneven grounds.
